

Procedures for Lacquerware Maki-e Hands-on Experience

- Please do not start until the instructor finishes his explanation.
- The painting material is cashew paint, instead of lacquer.
- The paint will stain your clothes. Please be careful.



- 1** After selecting a tray, apply paint to the brush to serve as “glue”. Use the plate to remove any excess paint, and use the tip of the brush for detailed work.

*Be careful not to apply too much paint.



- 2** For a beautiful finish, paint the empty areas being careful not to get paint on lines of the rough sketch. First, paint about 1/3 of the entire object.



- 3** Choose one color powder from among the 7 metal powders. Dip the brush in the powder, and sprinkle the powder over areas which have been painted to apply the color. You can use either one color or combine two.

* Applying color by sprinkling the powder is called “Makie”.



- 4** Repeat processes **2** and **3** at least three times.



- 5** Finally, add your signature to finish.
